### Game Overview

Lawrence opens up the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association portion of its schedule with a pair of games against Concordia (Wis.) this weekend.

### Series History

Lawrence holds a 5-1 all-time advantage against Concordia. The Vikings have won five straight in the series. Lawrence went 4-0 against Concordia a year ago.

### The Coaches

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski is in his fourth season behind the Vikings bench. Szkodzinski owns a 40-39-6 record in Appleton.

Tony Hrkac is 6-50-1 in his third season in Mequon.

### Scouting the Vikings

Lawrence enters the weekend 1-0 after a season-opening 3-2 win over UW-Eau Claire last Friday at the Appleton Family Ice Center.

Marc Howe scored the game-winner at the 14:12 mark of the third period to cap the Vikings first season-opening victory in 11 years. Six players scored points for Lawrence. Evan Johnson turned away 32 Blugold shots for his 19th career win.

Johnson owns a 2.00 goals against average with a .941 save percentage.

Lawrence was 1-for-5 (20.0 percent) on the power play and 6-for-7 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

### Scouting the Falcons

Concordia enters the weekend 0-3 overall and 0-2 in the MCHA after being swept by Milwaukee School of Engineering this past weekend.

The Falcons are averaging 1.0 goals per game while allowing 8.0 goals per contest. Three players have scored goals for Concor-

dia.

Sophomore Everett Devlin leads Concordia with a 5.00 goals against average and .881 save percentage.

Concordia is 1-for-27 (3.7 percent) on the power play and 14-for-24 (58.3 percent) on the penalty kill.

### Open For Business

With its 3-2 victory over UW-Eau Claire last Friday, Lawrence improved to 7-16-1 all-time in season openers dating back to the 1986-87 season. It was the first season-opening win since a 3-1 victory over Northland to open the 1998-99 campaign. The Vikings are now 1-9-1 in their last 11 opening games.

Lawrence is now 1-3 in season openers under head coach Mike Szkodzinski.

### New Look MCHA

The MCHA will have a different look during the 2009-10 season. Lake Forest will join the league after a stint in the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association. The Foresters will take the spot of Minnesota-Crookston.

### MCHA Minute

Since November 15 of last season, Lawrence is 14-3-1 in its last 18 games against MCHA opponents. The Vikings finished with a 14-5-1 MCHA record a season ago.

### Northern Lights

Lawrence's 3-2 victory over UW-Eau Claire last Friday was its first win in three tries against the Blugolds. It was only the fourth time in school history the Vikings have ever beaten a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association opponent.

## Start Me Up

Sitting at 1-0, Lawrence is trying to do something it has only done three other times before. The Vikings are trying to start 2-0 for only the fourth time in school history. The last time Lawrence started a season with two-straight wins was during the 1997-98 campaign when it opened 3-0. Lawrence has only started a season 3-0 once in school history.

## Freshman Firsts

Lawrence freshman Brad Scurfield became the first Viking player to score a goal in his first collegiate game since current Viking Billy Siers light the lamp in a 4-1 loss to UW-Stout to open the 2006-07 season.

Fellow freshman Gustav Ahlberg assisted on Ben DiMarco's power-play goal in the first period of the 3-2 win over UW-Eau Claire last Friday. The assist was Ahlberg's first career point.

## Nifty Fifty

Lawrence head coach Mike Szkodzinski needs only 10 wins to give him 50 for his career. Currently second on the Lawrence career wins list, Szkodzinski is only 12 victories away from becoming the school's all-time leader in wins. Dave Ruhly, head coach from 1999-2006, owns a 51-119-10 career record.

Lawrence finished the 2006-07 campaign 13-14-2, Szkodzinski's first season in Appleton. The Vikings went 10-14-3 in 2008 before posting a school-record 16 wins during the 2008-09 season.

## Tough After 2

Lawrence is 30-1-0 when leading after two periods under Szkodzinski. The Vikings' only loss came in a 6-3 defeat at UW-Eau Claire during the 2007-08 season. Eau Claire scored five unanswered goals in the contest.

## Four Or More

Lawrence is unbeaten in its last 28 games when scoring four goals or more under Szkodzinski. Overall, Lawrence is 30-2-2 when scoring four goals or more since the

Lawrence is 20-0-1 when scoring five goals or more over the past three seasons.

## Record Watch

Senior forward Marc Howe currently stands at 85 points (47 goals, 38 assists) for his career. With 85 points, Howe stands at sixth on the Lawrence all-time points list. Howe needs 19 points to become the school's all-time leader. Nick Jennette and Ryan Blick top the list with 103 points.

With 47 goals, Howe ranks second the all-time goals list at Lawrence. Howe needs three goals to become the school's all-time leader.

## Century Mark Matters

Lawrence has three players nearing 100 games played for their career. Senior forward Marc Howe has played in 84 career games. Billy Siers, a senior forward has played in 79 career games, while senior forward Masa Takahashi has played in 78 career games.

## D-Fence

Lawrence ranked 12th in the nation in scoring defense a year ago. The Vikings allowed 2.43 goals per game. Amherst led the nation allowing only 1.46 goals per game.

## Good To Be Home

Lawrence is 25-11-4 in home games over the past three seasons. The Vikings are 10-2 in its last 12 games at the Appleton Family Ice Center.

## Fully Automatic

For the first time in the 11-year history of the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association, the league's Harris Cup champion will receive an automatic trip into the NCAA Division III tournament field.

The MCHA has never had an at-large selection in the NCAA tournament despite strong seasons recently. In 2006, Milwaukee School of Engineering finished 21-5-1. Adrian College finished 26-3 in 2008 and 27-1-1 last season.

## National Leader

Junior goaltender Evan Johnson led the nation with seven shutouts in 2008-09. The seven shutouts placed Johnson second on the all-time shutouts list for a single-season in NCAA Division III history, trailing only St. Norbert's Kyle Jones. Jones posted 10 shutouts in 2007-08.

Johnson added to his already stellar year by setting single-season records with a 13-9-1 record, 2.11 goals against average and .912 save percentage.

## Many Happy Returns

Despite losing leading scorer Nick Jennette, Lawrence returns 75.3 percent of its scoring from a year ago. Senior forward Marc Howe tied for the team-lead with 14 goals last season.

## St. Norbert Connection

Three coaches behind the Lawrence bench have ties to in-state rival St. Norbert College. Head coach Mike Szkodzinski, and assistant coaches Scott Jewitt and Ryan Petersen all played for the Green Knights.

Szkodzinski fashioned an impressive 32-9-4 record between the pipes for St. Norbert. Szkodzinski, a member of the NCAA Division III runner-up team in 2006, owns a 2.21 career goals against average and a school record .917 save percentage.

Jewitt, college teammates with Szkodzinski, is a two-time All-Northern Collegiate Hockey Association team performer in his years at St. Norbert. Team captain as a senior, Jewitt places second on the St. Norbert career list for points, goals and assists.

Petersen, a two-year team captain, captained the St. Norbert's 2008 NCAA Division III championship team. St. Norbert won three NCHA regular-season titles during Petersen's four season.

## Going Pro

Lawrence all-time leader in points and goals Nick Jennette inked a professional contract with the Huntsville Havoc of the Southern Professional Hockey League at the conclusion of the 2008-09 season. Jennette set the NCAA Division III record with 111 consecutive games played.

APPLETON, Wis. -- Marc Howe's goal with 5:48 left in the third period lifted the Lawrence University hockey team to a 3-2 nonconference win over the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Saturday night at the Appleton Family Ice Center.

Lawrence (1-0-0) trailed 2-1 heading into the third period of the season opener for the Vikings. The Vikings tied it early in the third period on freshman forward Brad Scurfield's first career goal. Scurfield came up with the puck after a scramble in front of the net and stuffed it past Scott Pederson.

The Blugolds (0-2-0) had just killed off a penalty when Howe took a pass Sam Johnson and scored to put the Vikings ahead for good.

Eau Claire pulled its goaltender for the final 1:11 but Lawrence goaltender Evan Johnson made the Vikings' lead stand up. Johnson made 32 saves on the evening, and Pederson had 21 for the Blugolds.

Eau Claire led 1-0 when Isaiah Bennis scored at 13:22 of the first period. He picked up his own blocked shot and beat Johnson. The Vikings tied it at 1-1 just 2:48 later when Ben DiMarco scored on the power play for the Vikings off assists from Corey Garrett and Gustav Ahlberg.

The Blugolds took the lead back when D.J. Clark scored 6:31 into the second period on the power play.

Eau Claire was 1-for-7 on the power play, and the Vikings were 1-for-5 on the man-advantage.
