Game Overview

Lawrence looks to extend its best start in school history with a weekend doubleheader with Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association foe Lake Forest and Northern Collegiate Hockey Association opponent UW-Superior.

Series History

Lake Forest holds a 3-13-1 advantage over Lawrence. The Foresters defeated the Vikings 5-1 last Nov. 25 in Lake Forest.

UW-Superior and Lawrence have never met in ice hockey.

The Coaches

Lawrence coach Mike Szkodzinski is in his fourth season behind the Vikings bench. Szkodzinski owns a 42-39-6 record in Appleton.

Terry Fritz owns a 487-459-59 record in his 32nd season in Lake Forest.

Dan Stauber owns a 185-54-34 record in his tenth season in Superior.

Scouting the Vikings

Lawrence is off to its best start in school history at 3-0 after sweeping Concordia (Wis.) last weekend. Ben DiMarco led the Viking attack netting his first career hat trick in an 8-1 victory on Friday. DiMarco added a goal and an assist in the 4-2 win on Saturday to give him a six points (4 goals, 2 assists) on the weekend. DiMarco leads Lawrence with five goals on the season.

Marc Howe broke the Lawrence career goals record with his marker in the first period on Saturday.

Evan Johnson is 3-0-0 with a 1.76 goals against average and .932 save percentage between the pipes for the Vikings.

Lawrence is 5-for-17 (29.4 percent) on the power play and 15-for-17 (88.2 percent) on the penalty kill.

Scouting the Foresters

Lake Forest enters 2-1 after a weekend sweep of Finlandia. Trent Brown scored two goals and added three assists in the Friday win for the Foresters. Brown leads Lake Forest with three goals, three assists for six points.

Brendan Sullivan is 2-1-0 with a 4.67 goals against average and .865 save percentage in goal.

Lake Forest is 4-for-26 (15.4 percent) on the power play and 18-for-21 (85.7 percent) on the penalty kill.

Scouting the Yellowjackets

UW-Superior enters at 2-2 after posting victories over Concordia (Minn.) and St. John's last weekend. Tyler Fletcher leads the Yellowjacket offense with four goals. Braden Deseimet has six points.

Jim Patterson is 2-0-0 with a 2.50 goals against average and a .902 save percentage.

UW-Superior is 3-for-13 (23.1 percent) on the power play and 19-for-26 (73.1 percent) on the penalty kill.

Climbing Into The Poll

For the first time in school history, Lawrence made an appearance in the USCHO Division III poll. The Vikings appeared in the "others receiving votes" area. Lawrence had five points in the poll.

MCHA Minute

Since November 15 of last season, Lawrence is 16-3-1 in its last 20 games against MCHA opponents. The Vikings finished with a 14-5-1 MCHA record a season ago.

At 3-0, Lawrence is off to its best start to a season in school history, matching the opening to the 1997-98 season. The Vikings have started 3-0 only twice in school history, and have started 2-0 only four times. Lawrence has never started a season 4-0.

Record Breaker

With his goal at the 14:54 mark of the first period in Saturday's 4-2 victory over Concordia (Wis.), senior forward Marc Howe became Lawrence's all-time goal scoring leader. With 49 career goals, Howe passed former Vikings Nick Jennette and Mike Burkhart.

Howe currently has 90 career points, 13 shy of tying Nick Jennette and Ryan Blick for the career points record.

Trick Or Treat

Sophomore forward Ben DiMarco netted his first career hat trick in an 8-1 victory over Concordia (Wis.) last Friday. The hat trick was the first by any Viking since Marc Howe scored three goals last Feb. 7 against Northland.

National Rankings

Entering the weekend, Lawrence ranks high nationally in several statistical categories. The Vikings rank sixth in the nation in goals

per game, averaging 5.0 goals per contest. Lawrence ranks seventh in goals against per game, allowing only 1.67 goals per contest. Lawrence also ranks sixth in the nation in power play percentage, converting at a 29.4 percent clip.

Freshman Firsts

Lawrence freshman Brad Scurfield became the first Viking player to score a goal in his first collegiate game since current Viking Billy Siers light the lamp in a 4-1 loss to UW-Stout to open the 2006-07 season.

Fellow freshman Gustav Ahlberg assisted on Ben DiMarco's power-play goal in the first period of the 3-2 win over UW-Eau Claire last Friday. The assist was Ahlberg's first career point.

Sophomore Sensations

So far this season, the sophomore class has accounted for 9-of-15 (60.0 percent) of the Vikings goals this season, and 21-of-38 (55.3 percent) of the points. In all, the freshman and sophomore classes have accounted for 71.0 percent of the Vikings offense.

Tough After 2

Lawrence is 32-1-0 when leading after two periods under Szkodzinski. The Vikings' only loss came in a 6-3 defeat at UW-Eau Claire during the 2007-08 season. Eau Claire scored five unanswered goals in the contest.

Nifty Fifty

Lawrence head coach Mike Szkodzinski needs only 8 wins to give him 50 for his career. Currently second on the Lawrence career wins list, Szkodzinski is only 10 victories away from becoming the school's all-time leader in wins. Dave Ruhly, head coach from 1999-2006, owns a 51-119-10 career record.

Lawrence finished the 2006-07 campaign 13-14-2, Szkodzinski's first season in Appleton. The Vikings went 10-14-3 in 2008 before posting a school-record 16 wins during the 2008-09 season.

Four Or More

Lawrence is unbeaten in its last 30 games when scoring four goals or more under Szkodzinski. Overall, Lawrence is 32-2-2 when scoring four goals or more since the 2006-07 season.

Lawrence is 21-0-1 when scoring five goals or more over the past three seasons.

Century Mark Matters

Lawrence has three players nearing 100 games played for their career. Senior forward Marc Howe has played in 86 career games. Billy Siers, a senior forward has played in 80 career games, while senior forward Masa Takahashi has played in 78 career games.

Good To Be Home

Lawrence is 25-11-4 in home games over the past three seasons. The Vikings are 10-2 in its last 12 games at the Appleton Family Ice Center.

Fully Automatic

For the first time in the 11-year history of the Midwest Collegiate Hockey Association, the league's Harris Cup champion will receive an automatic trip into the NCAA Division III tournament field.

The MCHA has never had an at-large selection in the NCAA tournament despite strong seasons recently. In 2006, Milwaukee School of Engineering finished 21-5-1. Adrian College finished 26-3 in 2008 and 27-1-1 last season.

D-Fence

Lawrence ranked 12th in the nation in scoring defense a year ago. The Vikings allowed 2.43 goals per game. Amherst led the nation allowing only 1.46 goals per game.

Northern Lights

Lawrence's 3-2 victory over UW-Eau Claire last Friday was its first win in three tries against the Blugolds. It was only the fourth time in school history the Vikings have ever beaten a Northern Collegiate Hockey Association opponent.

Award Winners

A pair of Vikings have earned MCHA awards for their efforts in the 3-2 season opening win over UW-Eau Claire on Oct. 31. Junior goaltender Evan Johnson was named Defensive Player of the Week after stopping 32-of-34 shots en route to his 19th career victory. It was the third time Johnson has earned the award in his career.

Freshman forward Brad Scurfield was named the Freshman of the Week after scoring his first collegiate goal against UW-Eau Claire. Scurfield buried a shot past Blugold goaltender Scott Pedersen to tie the game 1:11 into the third period.

National Leader

Junior goaltender Evan Johnson led the nation with seven shutouts in 2008-09. The seven shutouts placed Johnson second on the all-time shutouts list for a single-season in NCAA Division III history, trailing only St. Norbert's Kyle Jones. Jones posted 10 shutouts in 2007-08.

Johnson added to his already stellar year by setting single-season records with a 13-9-1 record, 2.11 goals against average and .912 save percentage.

Many Happy Returns

Despite losing leading scorer Nick Jennette, Lawrence returns 75.3 percent of its scoring from a year ago. Senior forward Marc Howe tied for the team-lead with 14 goals last season.

St. Norbert Connection

Three coaches behind the Lawrence bench have ties to in-state rival St. Norbert College. Head coach Mike Szkodzinski, and assistant coaches Scott Jewitt and Ryan Petersen all played for the Green Knights.

Szkodzinski fashioned an impressive 32-9-4 record between the pipes for St. Norbert. Szkodzinski, a member of the NCAA Division III runner-up team in 2006, owns a 2.21 ca-

reer goals against average and a school record .917 save percentage.

Jewitt, college teammates with Szkodzinski, is a two-time All-Northern Collegiate Hockey Association team performer in his years at St. Norbert. Team captain as a senior, Jewitt places second on the St. Norbert career list for points, goals and assists.

Petersen, a two-year team captain, captained the St. Norbert's 2008 NCAA Division III championship team. St. Norbert won three NCHA regular-season titles during Petersen's four season.

Going Pro

Lawrence all-time leader in points and goals Nick Jennette inked a professional contract with the Huntsville Havoc of the Southern Professional Hockey League at the conclusion of the 2008-09 season. Jennette set the NCAA Division III record with 111 consecutive games played.
