FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Lawrence Academy of Music is pleased to consider your request for financial aid to assist in your musical study. We have two need-based scholarship assistance programs:

- #1)** Our primary funding program is through the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) pre-college scholarship program. Guidelines for this program are:
- Applicant must be eligible for Federal free or reduced lunch.
 - The student application form must be signed by a school counselor or school designee who has verified that the applicant is eligible for free or reduced lunch.
 - Home-schooled students are eligible if they meet income criteria. A current wage statement or recent IRS tax form must accompany application for home-schooled families.
 - The student application form must be signed by parent or guardian.
 - A Social Security number on each application is preferred.
 - Applicant must be a Wisconsin resident. If not, a parent with joint custody must be a Wisconsin resident.
 - Applicant must have completed 5th grade but not have graduated from high school.

If you feel you qualify according to the above guidelines, please fill out the **PRECOLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**, then take the form to the child's school for them to complete the lower portion and return to the Academy office.

- #2)** The second scholarship program is the Academy of Music Scholarship Fund. This is funded by fund raisers (TUTTI), special donations and gifts received designated for families requesting financial assistance. Funds are awarded as gifts are received. Fill out the **STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FORM** if you would like to be considered for aid. A copy of your most recent Federal tax form 1040 must accompany the application in order to be considered.

Only complete applications will be considered. We will respond as soon as possible with a bill that will clarify both any financial aid awarded and your financial obligation for Academy activities.
