



Lawrence Academy of Music Music Camp

Enjoy a week of serious musical fun at a residential camp for middle and high school wind and percussion instrumentalists. The music camp, sponsored by Lawrence Academy of Music, is held on the Lawrence University campus in Appleton, Wisconsin the week of July 19-25, 2009. Students will perform in a band, study with faculty from the Academy of Music and Lawrence University Conservatory of Music, attend concerts and recitals, and enjoy a week of recreational activities. Students are housed in university residence halls and are offered nutritious meals at Lucinda's in Colman Hall. The week concludes with a concert on Saturday morning for parents, teachers and friends. A commuter option is also available.

A day at camp includes:

- two band rehearsals
- a music theory class (fundamentals to advanced and ear training)
- an hour of instrumental instruction
- an arts-related elective class (visual arts, dance, music history, musical theater, jazz ensemble)
- camp choir rehearsal
- recreation period including swimming, tennis, volleyball

Each evening brings a concert:

- a guest ensemble of professional musicians and a faculty recital
- mid-week band concert performed by the students
- talent night where students demonstrate their creative abilities
- an auditioned recital of student-prepared solos
- jazz ensemble
