You may warm up in any of the open practice rooms in the lower level of the Music Drama Center.

JAZZ ENSEMBLE ODYSSEY HOUR: If you signed up for jazz ensemble as your first Odyssey Hour choice, you are automatically in the group. There are no auditions for jazz ensemble this year.

THEORY CLASS PLACEMENT TEST is taken in the Shattuck Hall (lower level of Music Drama Center), Room 4. Signs will be posted to direct you.

COMMUTERS: Instrument cases may be left in room 146 of the Music Drama Center, just down the hallway from the camp office. A waiting area for commuters is in the Harper Hall lobby area. Bring a book, magazine, or newspaper to read Sunday afternoon before dinner, or take a walk and look over the campus (within the boundaries – check the map you were sent). You will receive your schedule card at the end of the Sunday evening rehearsal.
