The String Project

In partnership with the American String Teachers Association (ASTA), Lawrence University was selected to implement a String Project—a teacher-training program for college students that also provides area children with affordable instruction on the violin, viola, cello and string bass. Classes are taught by Lawrence University Conservatory of Music string majors under the supervision of Lead Teacher Carrie Gruselle, a certified, experienced strings instructor.

Levels: **Dolce** is our entry level. Beginners in grades three and four are eligible to participate. Students receive instruction in a large group of mixed instruments using the “Essential Elements Volume 1” method book.

Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:30-5:15 p.m.

Allegro consists of those who are ready to continue their study in a string orchestra setting. They are in their second or third year of study. Instruction is from select string orchestra repertoire. Depending upon enrollment, students may also work from a method book (to be determined).

Tuesdays and Thursdays. 4:45 – 5:30 p.m.

Presto students have received instruction for three years or more prior to enrolling. Their instruction will be based on more advanced string repertoire. The most advanced in this group will be given additional enrichment chamber music experiences (formerly called the *Vivace* group.)

Tuesdays and Thursdays. 4:45 – 5:30 p.m.

Where: All classes will be held at Trinity Lutheran Church, 209 S. Allen St., Appleton.

When: Semester 2 classes begin January 3, 2012.

Instruments: Each student must also provide his/her own instrument. If instruments are not available at your school, rentals are available through local music stores. There are small basses available for rental through the Lawrence Academy. String Project members are expected to participate also in their school music program if one is available.

Tuition: Student fees will be \$82 for the **second semester** (January – May) plus a \$10 annual registration fee for all Academy students. You may pay in full (\$92) at your first rehearsal, or you may pay in two payments with the first payment, a non-refundable deposit of \$50, due at your first rehearsal. The remaining balance may be paid in full by February 15, 2011. If you choose the installment method, there will be a one-time installment fee of \$8. Please make checks payable to Lawrence Academy of Music. Once your deposit is received, you will receive a bill for the remaining payment.
