ARRANGEMENTS: The tour price is based on a minimum participation of 20 persons and includes planning, handling and operational charges and is quoted on the current rate of exchange, tariff rates and airfares in effect as of January 1, 2011. In the event of a marked increase or decrease in foreign currency or in tariff rates, the cost is subject to revision.

TOUR PRICING: This is an à la carte tour in which special group airfares and land tour costs have been packaged separately in order to provide the traveler with the most flexibility. There will be no substitutions made with regard to travel dates, accommodations and/or airfare departure cities. It shall be up to the individual traveler to secure alternate arrangements should they be required. Land tour costs are based on double occupancy. Single room accommodations are available at a supplementary charge of \$750/traveler.

TRIP CANCELLATION, BAGGAGE AND MEDICAL INSURANCE: You will be given the opportunity to purchase insurance coverage for cancellation due to illness or accident. In the event you elect not to purchase the trip cancellation insurance and you cancel from the tour, charges will be made without exception in accordance with the cancellation policy. LAWRENCE UNIVERSITY IS CURRENTLY INVESTIGATING INSURANCE OPTIONS. DETAILS WILL BE RELEASED AS THEY ARE OBTAINED.

CANCELLATION: If after making your initial deposit you find it necessary to cancel from the tour for any reason, there will be a charge of \$100 per person prior to April 30, 2011. For cancellation between April 30, 2011 and June 2, 2011, there will be a cancellation charge of \$350 per person. For cancellation after June 2, 2011, in addition to the \$350 per person charge, there may be additional cancellation charges from the airline, hotel(s), or ground service companies up to the full value of your tour cost. **IMPORTANT:** Cancellations will not be accepted by telephone and must be sent in writing to: Lawrence University, 711 E. PASSPORTS AND VISAS: A valid passport is required. If you do not already have your passport, or it will expire before the return date of the tour, we suggest you apply for it immediately. No visas are required for your tour.

GROUP AIRFARE: The group airfare of \$1150 per person is based on a minimum of 20 travelers. It includes economy class air transportation by scheduled flights of Delta Air Lines (or any other SkyTeam carrier) Chicago/Bordeaux – Marseille/Chicago. Meals and light beverages served during flights according to airline schedules. Airport departure taxes, Customs service charges, airline security fees and baggage are included in the group airfare per person price (subject to change).

AIRLINE TICKETING: For ticketing purposes legal first, middle, and last names are required (identical to your passport). Once airline tickets have been issued and if a ticket requires a name change because of incorrect information supplied to our office, the client is responsible for any applicable airline charges.
