

**DEPARTMENTAL/IA APPLICATION FOR
3RD YEAR APPOINTMENT FOR FELLOWS**

Appointment to a 3rd year as a Lawrence Fellow requires evidence that the Fellow's contributions are of high quality and that departmental needs merit a 3rd year. It also requires the consent and interest of the Fellow in remaining at Lawrence. Before completing this application, departments/IAs are expected to have determined that the Fellow is eager to pursue this application and intends to complete his or her own application (also required) for a 3rd year.

Please answer all of the following questions (use additional space as needed and feel free to append any supporting documents that may help the Committee):

1. Are there any particularly departmental or institutional needs that justify a 3rd year?

2. Are there continuing or new collaborations or projects (with students and faculty) that would be carried out in the 3rd year?

3. What courses or individualized instruction opportunities will the Fellow offer in the 3rd year?

4. Has the Fellow made programmatic contributions (e.g., generated an extraordinary amount of student interest in a new area) that justify a 3rd year? If so, what indicators (e.g., class enrollments, students planning on graduate work) document this interest?

5. Although the Fellows Committee has collected data that will help to judge the quality of the Fellow's contributions, please include any information on the quality of the Fellow's teaching and scholarship or creative work.
