Comprehensive fee

The equivalent of at least twelve terms (216 units) of tuition, less transfer or advanced placement credit, must be paid by single-degree students prior to graduation. Double-degree students must pay the equivalent of at least fifteen terms (270 units) of tuition. Students enrolled full time for more than twelve terms may elect assessment by the term or by the course for the thirteenth and succeeding terms.
