

Directions for Using Special Software in the Main Hall Humanities Lab

- Please check the Main Hall Humanities Computer Lab Software Map to see if the program is installed on a particular pc/Mac.
- If the program is not on a particular computer, it may run on any pc and/or any Mac. Check the software map to find the proper platform.
- You may also need the CD-ROM, which the map will indicate.* Put the CD-ROM into the disk drive.
- If the program is installed on a pc, access it by scrolling up the *Start Menu* to *Programs*, *Class Programs*, and then the name of the program. If you cannot find the program in the menu on a pc, click on My Computer, the D:\ drive, Programs and then the program name (click on the file with the .exe extension to start the program).
- If the program is installed on a Mac, access it by clicking on the applications folder or the OS9 applications folder in the dock at the bottom. Then click on the icon of the program you need. If the program has not been installed, run it from the CD-ROM by clicking its icon on the desktop. Then click on the program icon to start the program.

*To check out CD-ROMs, please see the monitor to turn in your ID, to sign in on the yellow Sign-in Sheet, and to get the CD-ROM. When you are finished, please return the CD-ROM to the monitor, sign out on the yellow Sign-in Sheet, and get your ID.
