VOCAL DELIVERY FACTORS 1 2 3 4 5

- Extemporaneous delivery style
- Enthusiastic/energetic delivery
- Adequate projection/volume
- Variety in rate, pitch, tone, etc.
- Clear articulation&pronunciation
- No vocal distractions (urns, uhs, ya knows, etc.)
- Proper grammar used
- Vivid/visual language
- Formality/professionalism in language use

NONVERBAL DELIVERY FACTORS 1 2 3 4 5

- Enthusiastic/energetic delivery
- Good visual contact with audience
- Good posture
- Appropriate movement and gesture
- Proper dress/appearance
