1. There will be a trip made to the DMV through ISS. If you need to apply for a state ID or a driver's license, you may sign up by October 30th by sending an e-mail to Tanuja. The trip will be on **November 4th 1:00pm, 1:30pm and on November 5th, 3:00pm, 3:30pm, 4:00pm** (if taking a written test, it is encouraged to go at the earlier time). The required documents include a completed **MV3001** form, SSN, passport (with valid I-94), I-20, certified school transcript or bank statement (at least 30 days old) with current address, \$28 or \$35 fee. Please check their website for alternative documents accepted. Most first-year students use the bank statement option as they cannot yet be issued a certified school transcript.
