



SUMMER HOUSING INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY: On-campus summer housing is offered to 2012-2013 continuing students who are employed at least 10 hours per week by Lawrence University, are doing paid summer research, or have an approved summer internship coordinated through the Career Center. **Summer housing is not open to graduating seniors.** Failure to maintain 10 hours per week may result in eviction from housing. Housing will be assigned through a seniority-based lottery for rooms in Trever Hall. The lottery number that you will be given for fall 2012 housing selection will be used during the summer housing selection.

PAYMENT INFORMATION: The first payment of \$350 is due by Wednesday, May 30, 2012 no later than 3:00 pm for **ALL** summer students. You will **NOT** be able to participate in summer room selection if the first payment is not made in full by the deadline. The second payment (*applicable to only full summer tenants*) is due by Friday, July 20, 2012 no later than 3:00 pm. Failure to make the second payment by the deadline may result in eviction from summer housing. Both payments can be made at the cashier's window, 1st floor Brokaw Hall. No refunds or prorating will be processed for those students who choose to check in or check out on a date other than those already established.

The University reserves the right to refuse housing based on previous payment/tenancy problems. University policies outlined in the Student Handbook remain in effect during the summer months. Violations of these community standards may be grounds for eviction.

1. Get a job	By May 29, 2012	Secure on campus employment or Career Center endorsed internship
2. Complete summer housing application	By May 29, 2012	Turn in a Summer Housing Application to the Campus Life Office by Tuesday, May 29, 2012. The form is available online at http://www.lawrence.edu/dept/student_dean/reslife/selection/summer.shtml
3. Make your payment	By May 30, 2012 @ 3pm	When you turn in your Summer Housing Application, you will receive an invoice to pay your first payment of \$350 to the Cashier in Brokaw (the Cashier will not accept your payment without the invoice). This must be paid by Wednesday, May 30, 2012 by 3:00pm at the Cashier in order to select housing on May 31, 2012.
4. Select housing assignment	May 31, 2012 @ 4:30pm	Attend summer housing selection on Thursday, May 31, 2012 at 4:30pm in the Hurvis Room.

TENANCY: Students who select the full summer or late summer housing option will move into their Term I/Fall housing assignment on August 7th and 8th, 2012. If you do not have a Term I/fall housing assignment, you may need to move into a temporary assignment on August 7th and 8th (housing will be extended to you as a courtesy until Friday, August 31, 2012). **Please notify the Campus Life Office as soon as possible if this applies to you.**

STAFFING: Residence Life will have Residence Life Advisors available to deal with summer community issues. These RLAs will report to the Assistant Dean for Campus Life, Curt Lauderdale.
