



Volunteer at the Housing Partnership of the Fox Cities!

Description:

The Housing Partnership provides affordable housing and support for low-income families in the Fox Cities. Volunteers participate in the rebuilding, renovating, and restoring existing properties to create these affordable housing units. In 2009, they served 93 families – 92 adults and 150 children. The average income for these families is \$10,488 annually, and over 50% of used to be homeless. Volunteering provides the opportunity to help people that really need it, with a non-profit organization connected to the people on a local, state, and federal level.

Directions:

Head north on Lawe Street for about 0.5 mi, and turn left on East Hancock Street. The Housing Partnership is located inside the Wireworks building on the left.

Volunteer Opportunities:

Home improvement tasks including painting, construction, demolition, repairing, cleaning, landscaping, snow removal, dry wall, cabinetry, carpeting, flooring, and basic electrical and plumbing work.

Qualifications/requirements:

No previous experience required. Staff will provide any necessary training and equipment.

Time Commitment:

Projects are always in progress, but continuous involvement is not required. Volunteering during the weekdays works best, but Saturdays are also available. Volunteer days for groups of 5-15 students can be scheduled about a month in advance.
