| 5     | A truly exceptional poster, including all the aspects of a “4.” Information presented on the poster is insightful and interesting. Poster avoids information “overload” presenting the viewer with information tying themes of the poster to themes of the course. The information presented is complemented well by the presentation of figures, graphs, tables, etc.                                      |
| 4     | Information presented is solid and interesting. The poster has both good and appropriate depth and breadth of coverage for the topic. The poster shows a solid and complete understanding of the topic by the authors   |
| 3     | Information presented is adequate but not particularly interesting. Does not present information in a manner that relates to the viewer or themes covered in the course. May fall victim to the information overload curse, and is simply a term paper glued to a poster board. Poster fails to present some interesting aspects of the topic. Either the breadth or depth of coverage is somewhat lacking. |
| 2     | Information is inadequate, with some factual errors and/or significant omissions. Breadth and/or depth of coverage is poor. Citations are insufficient.   |
| 1     | Information presented is wholly inadequate, misleading, or wrong. Citations are sparse or all together missing.   |

| 4     | Images and figures are sharp, clean, high quality pictures, graphs etc. Text is easy to read and concise. Headings are neat and make it easy to follow the information presented on the poster.   |
| 3     | Information is adequately displayed on the poster. Appropriate images are present, but lack the neatness/quality needed for a “4.” Text and headings are present, but their effectiveness is diminished because too small a font or sloppiness. |
| 2     | Poster displays any of the following characteristics: Text is either inadequate or difficult to read. Images/figures are inadequate and/or sloppy. Material is difficult to follow, individual panels do not connect to each other clearly.     |
| 1     | Poster as a whole is quite sloppy and/or inadequate.  |
