

Classroom projects completed summer 2008

Main Hall 012

- converted to new smart classroom
 - ceiling-mounted projector
 - desktop computer, laptop inputs, DVD/VCR player, aux video inputs, cassette player, media switcher, all housed in a custom-built cabinet
 - wall-mounted controller

Main Hall 008

- installed new mobile cart; secured in closet at back of room
 - projector
 - laptop, DVD/VCR player, cassette player, AV receiver, all housed in a rolling cart
 - speaker input jacks on wall

Harper Hall

- installed new projection system
 - ceiling-mounted projector
 - laptop inputs on stage and in booth, DVD/VCR player backstage and in booth
 - media switcher integrated with existing audio equipment
 - wall-mounted controllers backstage and in booth (linked)
 - video monitors installed backstage and in lobby
 - new patchbay installed and new mic line pulled between booth and backstage rack

Science Hall 202

- upgraded existing projection system
 - replaced ceiling-mounted projector with new unit
 - added a pull-out shelf with laptop on side of cabinet
 - replaced existing media switcher with new unit
 - added cabinet-mounted controller
 - reconfigured laptop and aux video input connections

Science Hall 102

- upgraded existing projection system
 - replaced ceiling-mounted projector with new unit

Main Hall 402 & 404

- upgraded existing projection system
 - replaced ceiling-mounted projectors with newer units

As of 2008, **76% of Lawrence classrooms are equipped** with computer and video projection equipment.

The national average in 2007 as reported by the 2007 Educause Core Data survey was 67.4%. The percentage has been growing about 5% per year for the past several years, so the 2008 average will probably be around 73%.
