



Dennis Huebner Pre-Law Stipend Request for Proposals 2018

Lawrence University is pleased to announce the availability of the Dennis Huebner Pre-Law Stipend, established in 2000 in honor and memory of Mr. Dennis Huebner '96. The stipend can offset or cover expenses related to exploring or pursuing opportunities related to a career in the legal profession.

Dennis Huebner of Necedah, Wisconsin graduated from Lawrence in 1996 with a degree in government and an intent to study law to prepare for a career in politics and government. Following his tragic death in 1999 an anonymous donor created the fund in his memory.

The amount distributed is typically \$500 to \$2000, depending on the nature of the funding request.

The minimum eligibility requirements are junior standing, a 3.0 Grade Point Average and the desire to pursue a law degree. Applicants can request funding to help cover and/or offset the costs of a variety of expenditures, including:

- Law School Admission Test (LSAT) fees
- Law School application fees
- Supplemental living expenses for a summer legal internship
- Projects that will further your preparation for the professional study of law

Application Procedures

Submit the following:

- (1) Maximum 500-word statement of purpose that explains your interest in the legal profession
- (2) A current resume that details extra-curricular activities and awards
- (3) Proposed budget listing projected expenditures
- (4) Two faculty letters of recommendation
- (5) Current transcript

Submit completed applications to the Kia Thao in the Office of Pre-Professional Advising & Major Fellowships in Memorial Hall, room 109 by **March 1, 2018**. For additional information, please contact [Kia Thao](#).

Note: Students who receive Huebner Awards are required to provide a written assessment of the value of this award in enhancing their preparation for and interest in enrolling in law school. This assessment must be sent to the [Kia Thao](#) via email by the end of Term I, following the summer award.

Applications will be considered and funding decisions made by representatives of a Lawrence faculty/staff review panel.
