

# SUMMER HOUSING INFORMATION

MARK YOUR CALENDARS WITH THE IMPORTANT DATES BELOW!

**ELIGIBILITY:** On-campus housing is offered to 2019-20 continuing students who: are employed 10+ hours per week by Lawrence University, are doing paid summer research, or have an internship approved through Career Services. **Summer housing is not open to graduating seniors.** Failure to maintain 10 hours per week may result in eviction from housing. Housing will be assigned based on current and fall housing assignments in combination with seniority of lottery number.

1. Get a job/internship	By May 1st, 2019	Secure on-campus employment or a Career Services endorsed internship. <b>Note: employment applications due to Human Resources by Feb 28, 2019.</b>
2. Complete summer housing application	By May 1st, 2019	Fill out the online application form by May 1st for guaranteed summer housing placement. Applications filled out after May 1st will not guarantee a spot.
3. Make your summer housing deposit	By May 1st, 2019	When you fill out your summer housing application, you will be prompted to go online and pay a \$50 summer housing deposit. You must pay this by May 1st to guarantee your summer housing placement.

**PAYMENT INFORMATION:** The non-refundable summer housing deposit of \$50 is due by May 1, 2019 for ALL summer students regardless of your length of stay and will go towards your first payment. You will **NOT** be guaranteed summer room placement if you do not make the deposit. If you will be on campus for more than one summer term, failure to make payment by the appropriate deadlines may result in eviction from summer housing. You can make payments on CashNet or in-person at the cashier in Brokaw Central. Students who choose to check in or check out on a date other than those already established will NOT receive refunds or proration.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:** There will be a campus-wide power shutdown between the dates of Sunday, August 4 through Wednesday, August 7, 2019. No check-ins or check-outs can happen during the shutdown period. Please watch for more detailed information to come.

**TENANCY:** Students will be assigned their housing for summer, with the opportunity to preference their roommate option. Students occupying double rooms will be assigned a roommate. Students who will reside on campus during the summer's third session will move into their fall term housing assignment between August 8 and 9, 2019. If you do not have a fall term housing assignment, you may need to move into a temporary assignment - housing will be extended to you as a courtesy until Saturday, August 31, 2019. Please note that once you pick up keys and move your belongings into your fall term room, you will be charged for the third summer term of housing whether or not you remain on campus.

**STAFFING:** Residence Life will have summer assistants available to deal with summer community issues. These assistants will report to the Associate Dean of Students for Campus Life, Amy Uecke.

*The University reserves the right to refuse housing based on previous payment/tenancy problems. University policies outlined in the Student Handbook remain in effect during the summer months. Violations of these community standards may be grounds for eviction.*
