What's the next step? There are multiple ways to get your books for the term.

1. **Go to the bookstore:** Need your book now, or want to be sure you can find a copy? Conkey's is the best place to shop. Professors submit their lists directly to Conkey's, so the easiest way to find the books you need is at Conkey's.
2. **Check the Internet:** Looking for a better deal? Try online book stores, like Amazon.com and Barnes and Noble, or check out online used book stores, like Half.com or Textbooks.com.
If you want to compare online prices, go to www.campusbooks.com. The site links you to different online book stores, so you don't have to search multiple places. PLUS, they give you access to internet coupons for the different sites.
3. **Ask around:** Have friends, or friends of friends who have taken the class? Know someone who's in the department? Not everyone sells their books back at the end of the term – check around. Chances are you might know someone who has the exact books you're looking for.
4. **Bring books from home:** Some classes use books that you may already have. Check the list early, and if your class isn't posted here, email your professor. A quick email now can save you from having to ship books from home or buy new books once you're back on campus.
5. **Check out the Co-op Book Sale:** “Get the price right,” by selling your old books and buying your new ones in one location. Held Sunday-Thursday the first week of each term in Riverview Lounge, Co-op goes all out to provide this great service to students.
6. **Be sure to shop early** – this ensures that you'll have your books for the first day of class. (Early shopping also means that you can save on shipping!)
