IMPORTANT ACADEMIC DATES & DEADLINES

March 26	FIRST DAY OF CLASSES Instructor approval is required to register for <u>ANY Spring Term limited enrollment class.</u>
March 26- April 6	FINAL REGISTRATION FOR SPRING TERM – ALL STUDENTS See your status page in Voyager for more information.
April 2	SECOND WEEK OF CLASSES BEGINS Instructor approval is required to register for <u>ANY</u> Spring Term class.
April 4	LAST DAY TO SUBMIT OVERLOAD REQUEST FORMS FOR SPRING TERM
April 6	REGISTRATION PERIOD ENDS <u>Spring Term:</u> last day to make class changes or select S/U option; deadline for F-repeat forms.
April 9-20	ADVISING MEETINGS FOR ADVANCE REGISTRATION FOR 2018-19 -- DEGREE STUDENTS ONLY All continuing, degree-seeking students are required to meet with their academic advisors to draft their schedules for the 2018-19 academic year. Students will NOT be able to register in Voyager until their advising holds have been released.
April 22- May 1	FIRST ROUND OF ADVANCE REGISTRATION FOR 2018-19 -- DEGREE STUDENTS ONLY Registration by assigned times only; see status page in Voyager for more information
May 3-6	MID-TERM READING PERIOD

May 18	LAST DAY TO WITHDRAW FROM A SPRING TERM CLASS

June 1	LAST DAY OF CLASSES Last day to request an ‘incomplete’ grade extension from the Dean of Academic Success.

June 4	TRANSCRIPT HOLD PERIOD BEGINS No transcripts will be issued for Spring Term students until all grades and academic actions are posted to student records.
June 4-6	FINAL EXAMINATIONS Final examinations are considered an integral part of the term. The final examination schedule is posted on the web at the Registrar’s Office and differs from the regular class meeting times used during the term. Petitions to change final examination times for travel purposes will not be approved. Students are expected to arrange travel plans around the final examination period.
