Incremental Tuition

Under certain circumstances, some students may be eligible to pay their tuition on a per-course basis.

Overload Fees

Students will be charged additional tuition (overload fee) if registered for more than 22 units in an academic term, subject to some exceptions. For 2023-24, the fee per unit is \$1,532. Music ensembles and THAR 355 and 357 do not count toward the 22 unit threshold. Each qualified student may take <u>one term</u> at 23-24 units without additional charge. See the catalog for details.

Tuition is charged for courses in which the student is officially registered, regardless of attendance or final grade. Overload fees will be charged based on a student's official registration for the term (attempted units). Failure to successfully complete and earn credit for all registered courses will not cancel or modify any overload fees that have been assessed.
