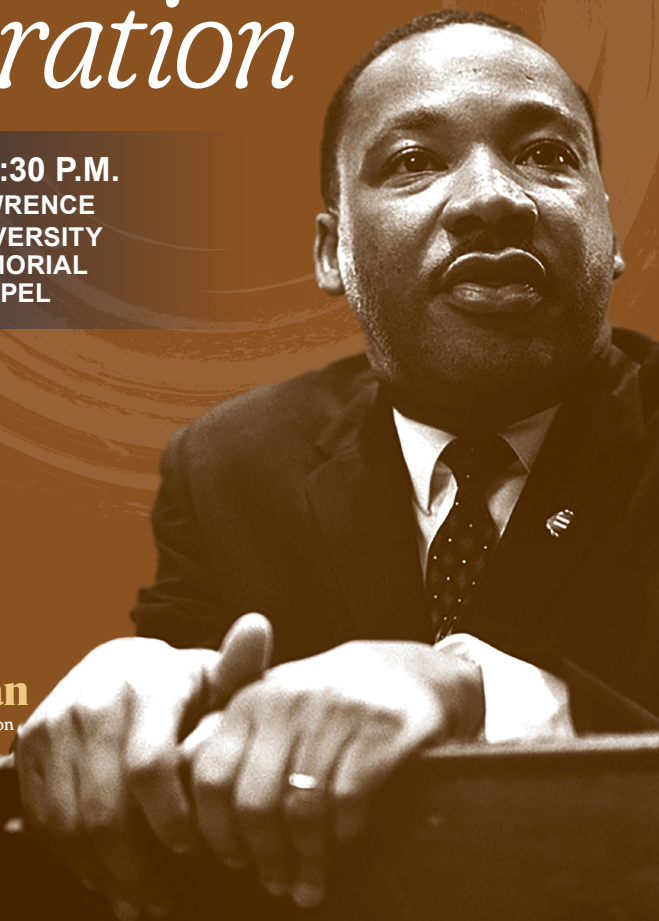

He is a highly recognized and awarded educational leader including being honored by Madison365 as one of Wisconsin's Most Influential Black Leaders of 2023 and Wisconsin's 2024 Man of Excellence.



Dr. Coleman was also recognized by the Oshkosh Northwestern Newspaper on the 2024 People of the Year List for his leadership in the Oshkosh Area School District. Most recently, Dr. Coleman was honored by the Wisconsin State Assembly for his influence and impact as a leader for education and opportunity in Wisconsin.

Dr. Coleman's work is focused on providing high quality education for all students, expanding access to opportunities, and closing gaps in achievement outcomes, particularly in reading and literacy, for students who have historically been marginalized by and within systems.

As a mentor, community servant, and youth advocate, Dr. Coleman believes that his calling in life is to help raise up a generation of leaders who will inspire unity, justice, pride, achievement, and self-determination.

Dr. Coleman earned an undergraduate degree in business, a master's degree in education from Louisiana State University-Shreveport, a Master's degree in education from Concordia University, a Master's degree in educational leadership from U-W Madison and a Ph.D. in educational leadership University of Wisconsin-Madison.
